
Dear Council Members,

The Stone Harbor Museum Maritime Annex has collected a number of sailboats that have raced in our waters in the past. We are attempting to preserve and rehabilitate these collectable artifacts. However the weather elements are taking a toll on the boats and we are in danger of losing our collection. The Stone Harbor Museum would like to have a temporary shelter for some of the boats in the Maritime Annex of the museum. This shelter is made of canvas and would not be permanently attached to the ground or any structure. It may be removed from time to time for display of the artifacts in the museum. The size could vary from 30' x 20' to 10' x 10'. Optimally we would like to place it on the cement pad in the rear of the property.

We asked Joanne Mascia, the Zoning Official if there would be any issues in setting up this type of structure, and she responded that a tent must be taken down within three days according to Borough Ordinance. Since the Museum Property is owned by the Stone Harbor Board of Education and leased to The Borough of Stone Harbor for Museum use, we are asking that the Borough give the permission for the Museum to use the tents to preserve the boats until a better solution could be found.



- Application Filing Fee	\$60.00 per event
- Seasonal Use by Local Schools	\$1,500.00 per season
- Charity Organizations	\$750.00 per season for second sport
- Use of Fields	\$60.00 Application Fee (No other fees to be assessed)
- Use of Fields	\$500.00 per day (first two days) \$250.00 per day each additional day
- Use of Fields	\$250.00 per day if before <b>Memorial Day</b> and after <b>Labor Day</b> and if the event is hosted by an Organization headquartered in Cape May County with at least five members from Stone Harbor.
- Chamber of Commerce	\$60.00 application fee for all Events

**Section 275-4. Exceptions.**

A. Special Events sponsored solely by the Borough of Stone Harbor are exempt from the payment of the fee for a special event permit. Such special events shall be governed by applicable Borough policies. Additionally, Borough Council retains the discretion to waive any provision of this chapter where deemed appropriate in the sole discretion of the Borough Council.
