WHEREAS the Borough of Stone Harbor is given authority by N.J.S.A. 40A:11 *et seq.* to enter into contracts for "Professional Services," without competitive bidding, where the need arises and so long as the award of such contract is made public by a Resolution of the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Stone Harbor requires specialized expert services in connection with Landscape Architecture Services related to the design of the Borough's September 11th Memorial; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor Design Group, Inc., 100 Technology Way – Suite 125, Mount Laurel, New Jersey has performed Phase One – Master Site Plan Development Phase for a total fee of \$9,200.00 as outlined in a proposal entitled "Proposal for Professional Services, Stone Harbor September 11th Memorial; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for award of this contract as evidenced by the Chief Financial Officer's certification of funds attached hereto;

BEST PRACTICES SURVEY
