### RICH, LANE JOIN STONE HARBOR BOROUGH COUNCIL

(Stone Harbor, NJ)—The Stone Harbor Borough Council held its official reorganization meeting on Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>. During the meeting, new council members Joselyn Rich and Karen Lane were sworn into office by Municipal Clerk Suzanne Stanford.

Rich and Lane will each be serving their first terms in office. They join fellow council members Judy Davies-Dunhour, Barry Mastrangelo, Al Carusi, and Joan Kramar. During the reorganization meeting, Kramar was unanimously selected to serve as Council President.

During the reorganization meeting six council committees were formed and their respective chairpersons were selected. The committees and council chairpersons are: Administration and Finance, Councilman Barry Mastrangelo; Public Works, Councilwoman Joan Kramar; Public Safety, Councilman Al Carusi; Natural Resources, Councilwoman Joselyn Rich; Beach & Recreation, Councilwoman Judy Davies-Dunhour; and Utilities, Councilwoman Karen Lane.

Borough Council conducted official business during the reorganization meeting. Council introduced an ordinance that names Mark DiBlasio of Remington, Vernick and Walberg to be the municipal engineer for the Borough. DiBlasio may be confirmed for the appointment during the February 7<sup>th</sup> council meeting. Council established the parking meter dates of operation for 2012 to be May 1<sup>st</sup> through October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. And, council announced that a joint meeting between council and the Realty Owners Association will be held on September 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 9am. This is the third consecutive year council has held a joint meeting with the ROA. Council also approved a change order for the recent construction work at the municipal boat ramp. That change order results in \$8,600 in savings for the municipality.

Council also created the position of Public Information Officer. Scott Wahl, who also serves as the Public Information Officer for the Borough of Avalon, was hired for the position. Wahl will be responsible for issuing press releases and improving communication between the Borough and the public. Joann DeVescio will continue to serve as Stone Harbor's Tourism Director.
